Highlights:

The average temperature was below normal (-1.0C below normal). All sites reported a negative anomaly (with the exception of Point Lepreau) and Bathurst recorded the largest negative anomaly at a temperature of -2.7C below their normal average.

Total precipitation amounts were slightly below normal, with an average of 92% of total precipitation. The province was drier in the east and wetter in the west. Bathurst was the driest and was just shy of receiving half of their normal precipitation while Oak Point saw over 1.5 times their normal precipitation for the month. Despite being cooler than normal, there was more rain than snow (128% vs 85%) recorded due to the event on Dec. 21-22.



December 2018; Climate Summary

Events:

Dec. 2-3; A low pressure system brought snow, freezing precipitation and rain to the province. Northern portions of the province saw near 15cm of snow while the south recorded 20-40mm of rain.

Dec. 17-18; Winter storm; A system brought snow and blowing snow with the southern portion of the province receiving the most snow 15-25cm (Bouctouche 30cm saw the most) while northern sections saw generally 10-15cm.

Dec. 21-22; Warm and wet. Several sites saw record breaking maximum temperatures and combined with snowmelt and rain, led to some localized flooding. Rainfall ranged from 40-60mm with eastern sections receiving the least at around 10-20mm. The most rain was recorded at Mechanic Settement with 103mm. The Campbellton area saw up to 5 hours of freezing rain before changing over to rain.

Dec. 28-29; Messy weather; A system brought a mix of precipitation with generally 5-12cm of snow across the province and 15-25mm of rain for the south, 2-5mm of rain for the north. Several sites also saw several hours of freezing rain during the changeover.


Days with temperature records broken or tied in New Brunswick; 6 21 22 (red=maximum, blue=minimum)






December 2018 - Temperature

Daily Mean Temperature (bold line) versus Normal (thin line) and +/- 0.7, 1.3, 2.1 SD (red/blue dashes)




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Daily Mean Temperature (bold line) versus Normal (thin line) and +/- 0.7, 1.3, 2.1 SD (red/blue dashes)




December 2018 - Precipitation

Observed Cumulative Precipitation (line) versus Normal (dashed line) and Daily Amounts (bars)



Observed Cumulative Precipitation (line) versus Normal (dashed line) and Daily Amounts (bars)




December 2018 Temperature departure from 1981-2010 mean.








December 2018 Total Precipitation







December 2018 Precipitation departure from 1981-2010 mean.








December 2018 Snow depth at month end






Weekly signature from GEPS 50km resolution



A strong signal of below normal for the first week then a weak to moderate signal of below normal for the remainder of the period.












Weekly signature from GEPS 50km resolution




Generally, a weak signal of slightly below normal throughout the period with the exception of the second week where there is no conclusive signal.


















Temperature anomaly by month in 2018
